TWELFTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME



A psychiatrist shared this interesting reflection during his speech to a group of businesspeople:

I once asked a very wealthy patient, "What do you do with all your money?" The patient replied, "To be honest with you, I guess, I just worry about it." "In that case," said the doctor, "do you experience pleasure from worrying about your money?"

With a deep sigh, the patient said, "No, but I feel such terror when I think of losing, or giving any of it away."

Commenting on what he termed his patient's "money sickness," the doctor said, "Generous people rarely have a mental illness, because they rarely lack for anything."

In the words of one such person, "My hobby is giving something away every day -- something tangible -- so that I will be reminded to give away the vastly more important intangible: a smile, a word of encouragement, a healing touch, an earnest prayer. I may not be a person of great wisdom, but this I know: the more I give to others, the more I have. I have an inner peace that comes from the assurance that truly it is better to give than to receive."

Certainly, he reads the Bible, because he knows that everything is a gift from God: undeserved and unearned and yet graciously and persistently offered. And I would say: Who am I to refuse? Moreover, we do not have the luxury of self-sufficiency when our generosity is tested in times of scarcity.

P.S. Just a reminder: A gift is pure when it is given from the heart, and when we expect nothing in return. It is not always easy but very rewarding, and especially when you regularly ask yourself, "What do I really need in my life?"
