### **Next weekend we will begin a Lenten mission in our parish.**

I want to invite you to a spiritual feast with **Fr. Francis Ching**,  
a Companion of the Cross priest from Toronto.

Fr. Francis will begin his mission during the weekend Masses on  
**Saturday, March 15 and Sunday, March 16,**

and will continue as follows:

**Monday, March 17 at 7 p.m.:** Fr. Francis will begin the evening of prayer  
and praise with the Holy Mass.

**Tuesday, March 18 at 7 p.m.:** He will begin again with the Holy Mass.

**Wednesday, March 19 at 7 p.m.:** He will also begin with the Holy Mass,  
and then we will continue with the Sacrament of Reconciliation.

**Thursday, March 20 at 7 p.m.:** Fr. Francis will begin with the final Mass.

During each evening, the Holy Mass will be followed directly by adoration.

During adoration, Fr. Francis will deliver his talk,

there will be response prayer time,

and he will conclude with the Eucharistic healing during the Benediction.

Can you think of a better preparation of your heart, mind and soul  
for the Resurrection of Christ than during this sacred time of blessing and grace  
when Jesus will be passing by?
